# PUBLIC QUESTION PERIOD

At the Council meeting of May 21, item 60.4 on the agenda was to authorize the hosting of the Montreal Symphony Orchestra for a concert at Centennial Park on Saturday, July 27, 2024, at 7:30 p.m. The approximate cost was estimated at \$41,000 for logistics and security costs at the site.

Council voted 4 – 2 against this offer by the OSM.

Councillor Robert Mercuri who voted in favour of holding the concert initiated, following this vote, a vigorous debate with the other members of Council as to whether we should revisit the decision made at the Council meeting.

Under the circumstances, I decided, as Mayor, to hold a Special Council meeting tonight to reconsider the decision that was made at the May 21 Council meeting, in view of the debate we had and additional information that was shared on City finances, as well as the misunderstandings on other out of budget expenses that were settled.

2024-05-211 WHEREAS the City is committed to enriching the cultural landscape and enhancing the quality of life for its residents and that it is a sought-after venue for large-scale prestigious events;

WHEREAS the Montreal Symphony Orchestra is internationally renowned for its outstanding musical performances and its ability to draw audiences from within and beyond the City, thereby contributing to the local economy and cultural prestige;

WHEREAS hosting a performance by the Montreal Symphony Orchestra will provide a unique opportunity for the residents of the City to experience high-quality orchestral music, fostering community spirit and cultural appreciation;

WHEREAS while recognizing the financial implications and costs associated with organizing and hosting such a high-profile event, the City acknowledges the long-term benefits and positive impact on community well-being and cultural development;

WHEREAS a major event, such as a performance by the Montreal Symphony Orchestra, considerably enhances the City of Beaconsfield's influence at the regional, provincial and national levels, by highlighting the City's commitment to cultural excellence;

WHEREAS the City is dedicated to ensuring that residents, including seniors or residents with reduced mobility, have access to cultural events and can enjoy them;

CONSIDERING THAT the City has very recently been able to secure a space for this clientele;

CONSIDERING the information set out in this resolution and the space available for Beaconsfield residents, the decision set out in resolution 2024-05-206 could be reconsidered, rapidly, since the OSM program is due to be published on or around June 4;

It is moved by Councillor Robert Mercuri, seconded by Councillor David Newell and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to rescind resolution 2024-05-206 and authorize the hosting of the Orchestre symphonique de Montréal for a concert at Centennial Park on Saturday, July 27 at 7:30 p.m. and the closure of Beaconsfield Boulevard from 5 p.m. to 10 p.m., and that logistics and security costs of the site in order to bring this cultural event to fruition, at an estimated amount of \$41,000 plus contingencies, be paid by the City;

That a limited space be reserved for Beaconsfield residents who are seniors or with limited mobility, ensuring that they have the opportunity to enjoy the performance in an accessible manner; and
